Outline of the role	Changeworks wants to make energy advice and support available to all members of society- especially those who need it most. We want to ensure that the right advice is delivered by the right people, right where and when it's needed.
	As an Energy Saving for All Volunteer you will be trained to deliver light touch energy advice and will support colleagues from the Low Carbon Community Team as they deliver outreach events to ethnic minoritised community groups.

	Volunteers will receive a toolkit of resources including translated advice sheets, poster templates, powerpoint slide decks,etc.
	Support at events and engagements is provided by Angela Mitchell, Low Carbon Community Officer.
	Support for vulnerable households is provided by Rima Said, Affordable Warmth Advisor.
	Kathleen Vaughn, Volunteer Coordinator, will deliver training and day to day support for all volunteers.
Time commitment	The project runs until March 2026.
