Outline of the role	Changeworks wants to make energy advice and support available to all members of society- especially those who need it most. We want to ensure that the right advice is delivered by the right people, right where and when it's needed. Changeworks manages two of the Home Energy Scotland advice centres.
	Home Energy Scotland is looking for volunteers to support their delivery at NHS Lothian vaccination sites across Edinburgh, starting in September. The links between warmth and health are well established, and this is why the Home Energy Scotland South East team has delivered services in healthcare settings for a number of years, supporting people to be warm and stay healthy at home. With volunteers supporting our Advisors we will be able to work engage more patients with advice to reduce their energy costs, be warmer in their homes and access a range of support. Support and training	Volunteers will receive training in the Home Energy Scotland service and how they will support.
	All volunteers must complete Data Protection training.
	Volunteers are encouraged to take up other training opportunities provided by Changeworks as appropriate.
	When out at flu clinics volunteers will be supported by an expert Advisor throughout.
Time commitment	The project runs until end of December 2024.
	Volunteers can choose which clinics they want to support according to their own availability. We ask that volunteers commit to a minimum of 5 days over this time period.
